

## Tour Plan



When *Adolf Hitler* had been appointed Reich Chancellor, a few weeks later on March 22 in 1933 a concentration camp for political prisoners was set up close to Munich in a small village called Dachau. This concentration camp became a *model for all later concentration camps* and served as the “*school of violence*” for the *SS men*. In the *twelve years of its existence* over *200.000 persons* from all over Europe were *imprisoned* here and in the numerous subsidiary camps. More than *43.000 died*. On April 29 1945, American troops liberated the survivors.

The Dachau Concentration Camp marks one of the darkest chapters of German history. Today it is a memorial site as well as an international site of remembrance, commemoration, learning and understanding.

### Barracks

First the barracks served to hold around 6.000 prisoners. When American troops liberated the camp more than 30.000 prisoners lived in horrible conditions.

### Bunker

The prison in the prison. “Special prisoners” were imprisoned here. Other prisoners from the barracks were brought here to be punished or murdered.

### Crematorium Area

Where dead human beings were burnt and executions were carried out.

**Arrival Gate "ARBEIT MACHT FREI"**  
Entering the concentration camp through this gate meant to give up belongings, dignity and all rights as a human being.

**Roll Call Square**  
This square which could hold 40.000 to 50.000 prisoners, served mainly for the prisoner roll call and the carrying – out of brutal punishment measures.

**Shunt Room**  
Prisoners were humiliated during the registration procedure, given a number and divided into a prisoner categorie.

We begin this tour at the Marienplatz with the early history of **Adolf Hitler** and his party the **NSDAP**. At different stops e. g. the **Hofbräuhaus** and the **Feldherrnhalle** we will explore the origins of the Nazi movement and its development during the 1920s. In the beautiful Hofgarten we will remember the courageous resistance against the Nazis by the Munich student group called **The White Rose**. At the end of our tour the former "**House of German Art**" sets the perfect example of pompous Third Reich architecture.

On this tour we guide you to the **authentic sites**. We will illustrate the darkest chapter of Munich's history with **historical photographs and other documents**.
